




The THEATIS Binocular, a product of one of the oldest and most famous optical factories in Europe, (J. D. Moller, Established 1864), has, since its appearance a year or so ago, literally taken the country by storm. Its advantages are so apparent at first glance that the old-fashioned opera glasses are cast aside immediately and as it is the ONLY pocket binocular which is flat in shape the demand for it is tremendous.

THEATIS is finished in black, is very elegant in appearance, comes in a flat, velvet-lined leather case, has a silk cord attached for suspension around the neck, and is guaranteed against flaws and defects of any kind.

To use the THEATIS it is simply necessary to adjust it, by bending, to the distance between the eyes so that a perfect circle is seen when looking through; then, in order to obtain absolute clearness of image each eye-piece is adjusted separately to its respective eye. Inasmuch as very few people have eyes which are absolutely uniform in visionary power it is evident that a great advantage is obtained by the ability to adjust each eye-piece separately. Both the central adjustment and the eye-pieces have number scales so that when once properly adjusted to the eye one need not bother about these adjustments again but simply turn to the respective numbers before using.
