

You see, the commentator has no time to think of colours as horses flash past at forty miles an hour. So the colours of the riders have to be memorised and my method is to paint them on a series of cards like playing cards. In the few days before the race I shuffle them up and keep on dealing them out naming each horse as its colour appears.

On the actual race day—the cards have finished their job. When the horses appear, the right name springs to my tongue as I see each individual racing silk because it's been well and truly memorised.




