


Let's take the mystery out of binoculars

A fine binocular is a lifetime investment, one which pays you ceaseless dividends in enjoyment; asks nothing in return except the same care you give your other fine instruments. Selecting the binocular most suited to your needs is not a tricky "numbers game." The numbers are nothing more than a simple, practical guide to help you select binoculars more quickly and confidently. Our business is binoculars, so let us help you take the mystery out of them right now!

DECODING . . . BY THE NUMBERS

Ever since Mr. Galileo made up the rules, the number preceding "x" (as in 7x, 35mm) has stood for power of magnification . . . meaning the binocular will bring an object that many times closer to the viewer; or make it appear that many times larger than it appears to the naked eye. Either definition is correct.

The number following "x" (such as 30, 35, 50, etc.) is simply the diameter of the front (objective) lens expressed in millimeters. This diameter is a factor in light transmission . . . a subject which is fully covered in the section titled, "Some Light Calculations."



DON'T BE 'OVERPOWERED'

As magnification increases, hand tremor becomes more noticeable ... steady viewing more difficult. In fact, the most significant reason behind the all-time popularity of 7x, 35mm models is that —a 7 power glass offers

—a 7 power glass offers the ideal magnification an average viewer can use without undue dis-

turbance. 6, 8 and 9 power binoculars are also considered standard, but above 9, prolonged viewing often requires something more substantial than hand-held support.


You can easily determine your most comfortable viewing, by looking at a detailed object through several different models. Be sure to allow for the effect of fatigue by holding each glass on target for two or three minutes.

CONFUSED ABOUT FIELD OF VIEW -

Well, don't feel badly . . . it's one of those things that have been complicated out of proportion by well-meaning, if somewhat overzealous 'experts.'

Field of view is simply the diameter (width) of the picture seen at any given distance . . . it varies tremendously among binocular brands and models, and is usually expressed two ways —

Look for a figure on the binocular showing degrees and minutes; such as, 8° 45'. This is **angular field. Field of view,** in turn, is expressed in an absolute figure, such as 460 feet. This means you see a picture of 460 feet diameter at 1000 yards . . . 1000 yards being a standard comparative distance.





8°45' angular field of view = 460' at 1000 yds. linear field of view

All else being equal, the widest field possible consistent with optical quality is highly desirable . . . especially for hunters and sports spectators.

LOOK SHARP . . . YOU CAN SEE THE DIFFERENCE



In binocular optics, like camera optics, the capacity to retain detail and clarity is called RESOLUTION . . . or DEFINITION. Take two 7 power glasses, widely varied in price. Unless there's false labeling involved, both will bring an object **seven times closer** . . . but the difference in distinguishing fine detail can be shocking! You can see the difference yourself, by trying to read a magazine with a so-called bargain binocular from the maximum distance you can read the same page with a better brand.

And while we're on this subject, there's the matter of prolonged viewing. Better binoculars are built with your eyes in mind . . . they're critically sharp and optically balanced to deliver eye-saving comfort hour after hour. The person who says after a short look, "I can see all right with this lower priced binocular," runs the risk of experiencing some degree of eyestrain every time he puts them to extended use.

Remember, SUPERIOR OPTICS are one of the main ingredients of high quality binoculars!

SOME LIGHT CALCULATIONS

A binocular's capacity to transmit light is dependent on three factors:

1. Optical quality 2. Coating
3. Size of exit pupil

Coating

Most modern binoculars have some hard-coating; although often not enough. The purpose of hard-coating is to reduce reflection, and for best results it must be applied on all optical surfaces. A simple test of this is to catch the reflections of a white fluorescent tube in the objective end of the binocular, and again in the eyepiece. On both ends, you will see a reflected image of the tube from each external and internal optical surface. On a 100% coated binocular, all images will be either blue or amber (either is acceptable) . . . otherwise, every white image will represent an UNCOATED surface.

100% coating is standard procedure in the crafting of better binoculars.

Exit Pupil

While you're looking, notice the bright disc of light emitted from the eyepieces. This is the exit pupil which transmits light to the eye. Its diameter is determined by dividing

the magnification of a binocular into its objective lens diameter (for example, a 7x, 35mm binocular produces a 5mm exit pupil). For normal use, including occasional night viewing.

a 3.75mm (8x, 30mm = 3.75mm) or larger exit pupil will be sufficient. If night viewing is your dominant use, the 7x, 50 mm binocular offers a huge 7.1mm exit pupil, which corresponds to the widest opening of the human eye.

BETTER BINOCULARS COST LESS TO OWN . . .

Any top-notch binocular will take hard knocks in stride . . . we mean the normal, day-to-day punishment that a less ruggedly constructed glass might not endure. The owner of a "bargain" binocular can easily spend many times its original value in repairs . . . and he'll still end up with something much less than the best.
