And as the sixteen runners went past the post, I named them all. People often ask me how it's done. Well, good binoculars, a quick eye and tongue, but most of all, plenty of homework. You see, the commentator has no time to think of colours as horses flash past at forty miles an hour. So the colours of the riders have to be memorised and my method is to paint them on a series of cards like playing cards. In the few days before the race I shuffle them up and keep on dealing them out naming each horse as its colour appears.

On the actual race day—the cards have finished their job. When the horses appear, the right name springs to my tongue as I see each individual racing silk because it's been well and truly memorised.


### Note for DENHILL BINOCULARS by Raymond Glendenning

Yachting takes me back to Helsinki—to the hours I spent afloat on the island studded waters of the fiord watching those tiny "International Class" Dinghies jockeying for position and the best of the breeze: getting up as close to the line as they dared, edging, tacking and then, as the starting gun boomed, thirty or forty of them nosing up the first stretch.

It's a tricky job, manoeuvring these craft, for the crew consists of one man and, apart from keeping a hand on the tiller and adjusting the sheets he has to spend half his time sitting over the side to balance the boat. On then to the various turning buoys—keeping well ahead of them—the only way of distinguishing them being often by the number on the sail. Yes, identification was tricky and good glasses were a necessity.
